

Fall Financial Update September 2022

The Cathedral continues to be in a deficit position for 2022.

Bishop and Chapter, upon recommendation of the Finance Committee, felt it was important the congregation be updated with additional information on the Cathedral's financial position. We are sharing this information as planning begins for the 2023 budget.

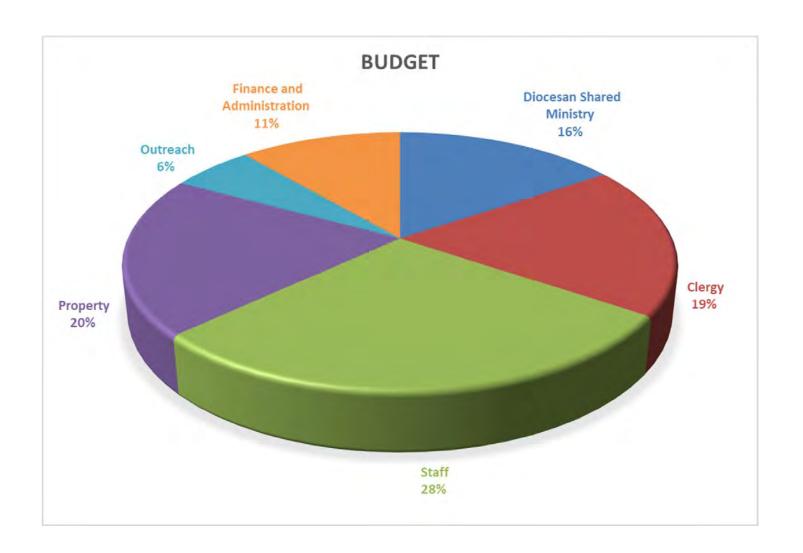
Some key trends (August 31, 2022):

- We are currently in a \$42,063 deficit position. This compares to a surplus position last year.
- General offerings are down \$43,511 compared to last year.
- Operating expenses are up 10.4% this year compared to last year.
- Total income is \$60,047 behind our budget target.

Note: Our deficit is technically \$57,063 if we remove from income the "increased" Diocesan grant we receive each quarter.

Summary:

We will be challenged to finish 2022 with a balanced budget. Our offerings are down and our expenses are up. Our current financial position will have significant impacts on our 2023 budget plan. Currently, we would need a 10% increase in our revenues to bring our finances into balance. Difficult decisions in terms of ministry, staffing, and our capital plan, may need to be made if offerings do not return to historic levels.
